Trinity Metro launches downtown Blue Line

The free Trinity Metro service — funded by Visit Fort Worth and Downtown Fort Worth Inc. — was introduced as the replacement for the Molly the Trolley route. The **Blue Line** route debuted on June 8, the day after Molly the Trolley ended its service. The new route will operate daily from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., traversing the city core every 7 minutes to transport locals as well as Fort Worth's 11.5 million visitors each year.

Visitors will be able to easily access the route, which stops at attractions such as Sundance Square, the Fort Worth Convention Center, the Fort Worth Water Gardens, and many downtown hotels. Riders on the new route would have to wait about 4.5 minutes to board a Western-themed **Orange Line** bus to the Fort Worth Stockyards that launched in 2024 as part of a plan to introduce color-coded routes. Fort Worth's Fourth is a high-flying, flag-waving patriotic festival like no other in the United States.

40th Anniversary Addison Kaboom Town Thursday, July 3 | 5pm-11pm Addison, TX

Since 1985 one of the nation's most impressive and unique Independence Day celebrations has been held in Addison. Each year approximately 500,000 guests from across the country converge on this small town to view the incredible Addison Airport Airshow, followed by a spectacular fireworks display.

Whether enjoyed from a restaurant watch party, hotel balcony, or the award-winning festival in Addison Circle Park, attendees are sure to be immersed in patriotic revelry. The 25-minute-long fireworks show is among the best in the nation, and it is simulcast on both local radio and on the town's social media channels.

Before the fireworks, there'll be high-energy music at Addison Circle Park from both the 36th Infantry Band (the Texas Army National Guard's esteemed Army band, based at Camp Mabry, Austin, Texas), and by The Elton Johns, a high-energy tribute band. Popular party band Emerald City All-Stars will perform after the fireworks.

Families viewing the fireworks from Addison Circle Park will enjoy festival food, beverages and an activity-packed area for the kids.

It's that time of year again-- summertime means the return of \$1 admission at the Dallas Zoo! Each year, the Dallas Zoo drops its admission price to only \$1, along with specials on food and drinks for anyone ages 3 and older (admission is always free for ages 2 and under). Dollar Days is a way of giving back, making the Zoo accessible for all, and saying "thank you" to the community for their yearround support. These days sell out every year, so get your tickets NOW!

Drinks and snacks

- There will be \$1, \$2, and \$3 deals on select snacks and beverages, including popcorn, ice cream, canned drinks, and more.
- Guests may bring their own food and drinks, although glass items, alcoholic beverages, and single-use disposable straws are not permitted. You may bring a refillable water bottle to fill at the Zoo's water refill stations!

Buy your tickets in advance

 Must purchase online! Select your preferred date in the ticket purchase path to get your \$1 admission tickets for those days. Remember, you're looking in the calendar for July 17 and Aug. 5 for the Dollar Days!

Parking is limited

- Parking will not be available for purchase online; it must be purchased on-site. Parking is \$12.00 (free for members) and will be collected at the ticket booths at the Zoo.
- Parking at the Zoo is limited, especially on busy days. To make your visit easier, it's recommended using the DART Red Line, which drops you off right at the Zoo's entrance. DART Park & Ride lots are a great option for avoiding traffic and parking delays.



With the FIFA World Cup coming to North Texas in 2026, excitement is building among soccer fans. Arlington's AT&T Stadium, temporarily under the alias Dallas Stadium, will host nine matches after the World Cup opens in Mexico City on June 11, 2026. Those nine matches are the most of any city across the three host countries, which include the United States, Canada, and Mexico. Details about teams, match schedules, and transportation are still being finalized.

Please be aware of potential scams...especially those unfamiliar with the FIFA ticket buying process. Avoid any offers from unofficial sources, including social media and resale websites. The safest way to buy tickets is through the official FIFA website. If you try to resell them, you have to do it through the FIFA portal...(you cannot use Ticketmaster, Stub Hub, or any of those third parties). Single tickets have not yet gone on sale and all information will be released through FIFA'S official channels. Everyone attending the World Cup must have a credential badge with your photo, nationality, and other information to enter the games. If you just have a ticket but you do not have your actual credential badge, they will not let you in.
