Myth and Marble Sept. 14, 2025-Jan. 25, 2026 Fort Worth, TX



This fall, for the first time in its history, the Kimbell Art Museum invites visitors to step into the world of Ancient Rome through a rare and remarkable exhibition, Myth and Marble: Ancient Roman Sculpture from the Torlonia Collection. Formed in the 19th century by Prince Giovanni Torlonia and his son Alessandro, the Torlonia Collection is the most important private assemblage of Roman marble sculpture in the world. What makes this collection especially compelling is its origin: many pieces were acquired through purchases of earlier aristocratic collections in Rome and excavations on Torlonia family lands. In 1876, Alessandro opened the Museo Torlonia to display these works. But after World War II, that museum was closed, and many of these masterpieces slipped into near-obscurity. Only in recent years have restoration and renewed public access brought them back into view. This exhibit features fifty-eight masterpieces, many of them rarely seen or not seen in public for decades.

Seeing Double: Two Clubs Born at the Fort Worth Zoo

The Fort Worth Zoo is celebrating the arrival of two lion cubs born June 29, 2025, to parents Saba and Jabulani. The siblings—a bold little female named Imara ("strength") and her sweet-natured brother Tamu ("sweet")—are thriving behind the scenes as they bond with Mom.

These births mark another conservation milestone for African lions, a vulnerable species. The Zoo's lions bring valuable new bloodlines to North America through a cooperative breeding program that helps ensure a healthy population for the future

The cubs are already showing playful personalities, wrestling and exploring their newly "baby-proofed" habitat, while Saba proves to be an attentive and nurturing mother. Visitors may spot the growing pride in the Zoo's expansive Predators of Asia & Africa habitat, but for now, updates on the cubs can be found on the Zoo's social media. The Zoo is part of a cooperative breeding program among North American zoos to help ensure a genetically diverse and thriving population of African lions.
